### **Safe Work Instrument**

#### **1 Title**

This is the Health and Safety at Work (Hazardous Substances—Modified Application of Controlled Substance Licence Requirements for Specified Class 1 Substances) Amendment Safe Work Instrument 2025.

## 2 Commencement

This safe work instrument comes into force on 30 June 2025.

## 3 Principal safe work instrument

This safe work instrument amends the Health and Safety at Work (Hazardous Substances—Modified Application of Controlled Substance Licence Requirements for Specified Class 1 Substances) Safe Work Instrument 2023.
